

Green / Sustainable Practices

- **Four Hearth 'n Kettle Restaurants** throughout southeastern Massachusetts
- **The John Carver Inn & Spa** in Plymouth
- **The Cape Codder Resort & Spa** in Hyannis
- **The Dan'I Webster Inn & Spa** in Sandwich
- **Beach Plum Spas** in Plymouth, Hyannis and Sandwich

- Linen Re-use Program in all hotel guestrooms
- Energy efficient LED light bulbs and timer switches used to reduce waste of electricity
- Paper recycling containers in all hotel offices
- Cardboard recycling
- Recyclable tote containers used for produce storage to minimize need for cardboard boxes
- Recycling bins for guest use in Cape Codder Residence Club
- Water reduction program using low-flow toilets and showerheads
- Biodegradable toiletries in hotel guestrooms
- Ozone air filters in some room types
- Energy provided by a Co-generation unit in some locations, resulting in a reduction of carbon dioxide emissions (by up to 70%) and nitrogen oxides
- Low chemical gardening practices
- Use of High Intensity UV Light technology for swimming pool water quality maintenance, providing the highest level of sanitation while reducing the amount of chlorine required.
- The Hearth 'n Kettle Restaurants are committed to making as many ingredients as possible fresh, nutritious, all-natural, organic, gluten-free, hormone-free, antibiotic-free and free of artificial preservatives.
- Fryer Oils are recycled in a fryer oil reclamation program.
